

Commercial Fishery - Geoduck Supply 1980 to 2002 Haida Gwaii/Queen Charlotte Islands

Each block within a bar represents the annual catch from one DFO management sub-area, ranked from highest to lowest catch value. Within this ranking, HIGH commercial supply areas (red) are defined by the highest ranking sub-areas necessary to make up at least 40% of the total annual catch for all sub-areas with catch information, MODERATE supply areas (orange) are defined as the subareas that make up the next ~40% of catch, and LOW supply areas (yellow) make up the final 20% of catch. UNKNOWN CATCH areas (purple) represent the total combined catch within all sub-areas where catch data was not provided due to DFO confidentiality protocols. The white numbers are the total # of vessels that fished each year.
