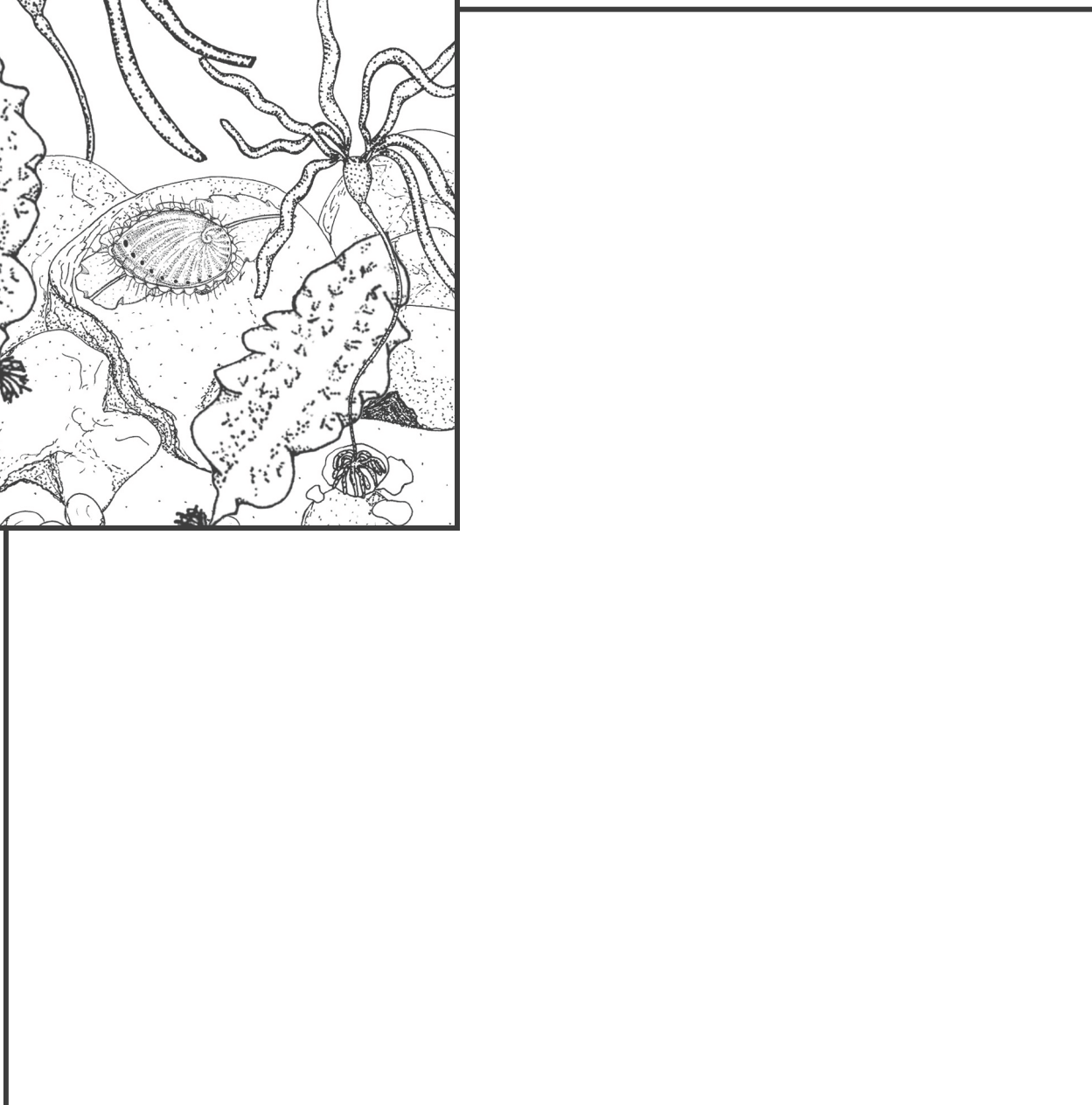
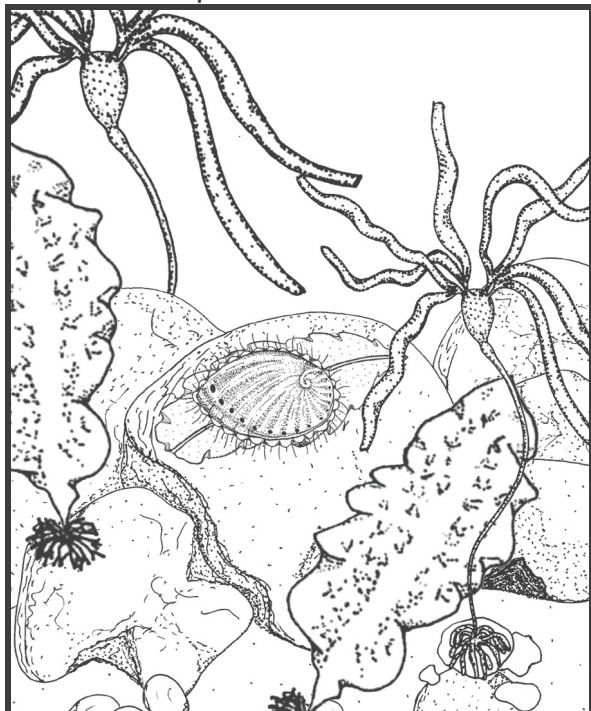
Lesson 6 Habitat
